

## **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-19**

I extend a hearty welcome to all those, who have come to share our joy in celebrating College Day, and recapitulate the memories of the Founder Secretary, Sri Nannapaneni, who passed away on this day in 1980, I extend a hearty welcome to you all.

As the FAC Principal of this august college, I deem it a privilege to present a brief report of the activities of the institutions. This year the strength of the UG & PG and Inter students has come to about 1000. The pass percentage of B.Sc CBZ is 90%; MPC students 81%; B.Com 91% and B.A 97%.

Following the guidelines of the UGC and NAAC, the devoted Management and committed IQAC team are putting maximum efforts to fulfil the prime vision of our college to send out of its portals knowledgeable, socially responsible, skilled and competent citizens with real human values and abilities to know, to do and lead purposeful lives.

Our academic year began with Orientation program to the teaching and non-teaching staff on the first day, and a week orientation to 3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> semester students by the staff concerned, and after the closure of the admissions orientation for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester students on autonomous system, examination system, continuous evaluation, internal & external exams by the Controller of examinations, Orientation of student support services available in the library by the librarian, Induction program by the coordinator. Bridge courses for about ten days to assess the category of the students.

IQAC oversees the overall quality control, of all dimensions of the academic activities of the College and puts efforts to promote holistic academic excellence. In brief IQAC is the heart and soul of the institution, which shoulders the responsibility of improving the performance of the institution – both academic and administrative, and has been the impetus behind the internalization of quality culture and the institutionalization of the best practices that are the precursors of quality enhancement.

The Institution faced two academic exercises NAAC Peer Committee for accreditation on 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> September and UGC Committee for extension of autonomy on 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> September.

Two UGC National Seminars are organized a) One-Day National Seminar by IQAC in collaboration with the Alumni Association on “Recent Trends in Students Anti-Social Behavior Implications for the Future of Education” on 19<sup>th</sup> December & One-Day National Seminar on “Skill Development – Need of The Hour” by the Department of English in collaboration with the IQAC & Alumni Association on 14-02-2019.

Effective staff guardian system takes care of the academic and personal problems of the students, eleven skill-based, employment oriented certificate courses to make them fit to face global competition, exposure to the society to inculcate social responsibility, Guest lectures and attempts to bring out the innate talents of the students through Performing Arts sessions, implementation of student centered learning offering technological base, including library & games hours in the time table, paying attention to their grievances and striving for sending the students out of the portals as knowledgeable, socially responsible, skilled and competent citizens with real human values, which is the prime mission of our college.

In addition to the best practices of the institution, each department has its own best practice. Awareness programs on food adulteration, AIDs, Health and Hygiene, hazards of environmental pollution Lab on Wheels, Caring & Sharing Cheyutha, motivational classes in schools, medical checkups for the public too are a few to mention with.

Feedback from all the stakeholders is taken and giving importance to their suggestions, revision of syllabus to the extent needed, encouraging student centric learning quiz programs, buzz sessions, Group Discussions, Role Play, Simulations, Problem Solving – Case Studies, Projects, Library and Field Work, etc.,

For physical wellbeing, students are given access to gym, indoor stadium and playgrounds to play any game of their choice. Intra mural competitions are held every year. To improve concentration, memory power of the students and to help them lead stress-free life, a roof Pyramid, is constructed and yoga and meditation is given priority.

Games and Library hours are included in the timetable. Swach Bharath is given importance. NCC cadets are benefited the UGC has chosen our Institution to include NCC as an Elective Subject for NCC Cadets.

As every Department arranges two guest lectures and observes two important days, and IQAC organizes two National Seminars in collaboration with the Alumni Association, as outreach programs and extension activities are given priority as they inculcate social responsibility, student centric activities and programs like Lab on Wheels attract the attention of schools, that send their students to our college - the college buzzes with student activity.

The sprawling playgrounds attract the district officials and University authorities and naturally a it has become a centre of number of selections, and coaching camps. University selects four or five student players from our college to represent our parent university in different games. Students are good at Cultural events and they participate in intercollegiate competitions and Yuvatharang and bring laurels to the college. NSS & NCC participate in the programs organized by the Government, go out to create awareness on several burning issues and they make a mark.

As it is a service oriented institution, even public is allowed to make use of the grounds for walking purpose, Pyramid to meditate, indoor stadium by alumni and others, Library by the outsiders, who go for competitive exams, playgrounds to play.
