

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

As the FAC Principal of this august college, I deem it a privilege to present a brief report of the activities of the institutions. This year the strength of the students is about 950. CBZ students achieved 100%, MPC students 79%, B.Com students 96% and B.A students 76% success in the final exam.

Following the guidelines of UGC & NAAC, the college is going ahead with quality culture. The common syllabus prescribed for all provides the knowledge aspect. As an autonomous college, all the staff members discuss and decide to revise the syllabus to the extent possible to provide the other components like technology, skills etc , without which it is difficult to face global competition. Though attempts have been made to shift teacher teaching and learning to student-cantered teaching and learning, it takes some more time to accomplish it.

Under the stewardship of the IQAC coordinator, students are exposed to several activities. As most of the students hail from rural background with no educated person in the family to guide them, Staff guardianship is given lot of importance. All the staff members are the guardians and second parents of their wards, they take personal care and try to mould them into socially responsible citizens, which is one of the missions of the institution.

The college offers 3 UG and 02 PG Programs duly affiliated to the ANU University and approved by the Department of Higher Education. UGC has chosen our college to be one of the two colleges in AP to run NCC as an Elective Subject. This year one more program-B.Com Computer Applications is added. In addition to that the various departments offer 12 skill-based, career-oriented courses and students are offered training to face global competition.

Orientation/ Faculty Development Program for the staff are organized on the very first day by the IQAC. Correspondent addressed the staff and stressed the importance of quality education. Five-Day Faculty program for teaching staff is organized from 07-06-2019 to 11-6-19 and another One-Day Faculty Program for staff on blog creation on 8-7-19. Two-day Faculty program for Non-teaching on Computer literacy from 10th to 11th July.

Eleven One-Day Workshops are organized for the staff and students over the year. Orientation classes for a week are organized by different departments. Soon after the admissions, orientation for the first semester students is organized by the Controller of Exams on the autonomous system, examinations etc., the Librarian has organized three-day orientation on the student support services available in the library, Induction program by the coordinator SIP is conducted.

A number of statutory and non-statutory committees are constituted for the smooth functioning of the administration. Research Promotion Cell successfully motivated the staff

so that, the college has well qualified and competent faculties to face challenges of higher education. Out of 24 aided members, 14 members have Ph.D to their credit, 3 members have submitted theses and three members are pursuing research. Four members have been guiding research scholars and this year, they have produced 4 Ph.Ds.

About twenty committees are constituted and every committee has two students as members so that they can be part of decision making.

IQAC has conducted 7-Day Workshop on Teaching and Learning for Sustainability from 14-11-2019 to 20-11-2019. Prof. K Rosaiah, Registrar ANU was the chief guest. In collaboration with IQAC, the Department of English has organized a UGC sponsored (autonomous fund) National Seminar on Learner Centered Approaches and Effective Classroom Management on 28-2-20. Dr. A.S Rama Krishna (MLC) Krishna, Guntur Teacher Constituency was the chief guest and Prof M. Suresh Kumar, of Acharya Nagarjuna University, delivered keynote address. Forty eight papers are presented.

ICT enabled infrastructure is provided in the form of Smart rooms, internet access in the central library free of cost, Web- based assignments, Presentation of the study projects through power point presentation, making use of interactive boards; smart classrooms are a few steps in that direction. Students are exposed to Quiz & Buzz programs, Group Discussion, Seminars, Case Studies, Role Play and Problem Solving Sessions.

To inculcate value system among students, the last hour of every Saturday was allotted for Performing Arts, to bring out the latent talent in the students as they have to speak on values, Gender equity, environmental protection, social responsibility and justice etc.

Provided experiential learning through project-based learning, Field work, Surveys, experiments and practical classes.

Having realized the importance of Intellectual property Rights, three One-Day workshops on Intellectual Property Rights & Entrepreneurship are organized. For the three streams lectures on Fundamental Rights and Duties, Universal truths; National symbols and their importance, significance of the logo of the college are organized.

Parent Teacher Association meetings are officially organized twice. Alumni of 81-84 met in the college on 21st July.

Keeping the mission of sending out of its portals knowledgeable, socially responsible citizens in mind, the institution motivates students to take up outreach programs and the result is programs like Caring & Sharing, Cheyutha,

10 members were selected by the University. 4 members participated in Handball tournaments at National level; 3 members participated in Softball tournaments at National level. In intercollegiate tournaments our students secured 2nd place in Soft ball; handball and weightlifting.

In cultural events also our students made a mark. In State level competitions 1st prize in Fancy dress; in University level competitions, our students participated in Group dance, Skit, Solo dance, Elocution and Singing. In intercollegiate competitions students secured 1st place in Drawing and Elocution, 3rd prize in Quiz, 2nd prize in skit at District level competitions, 2nd prize in mono action, Singing, Elocution in district level youth festival, 1st & 2nd prizes in Elocution; 1st prize in Drawing; 1st prize in skit & Modern dancing.

Vehicle Day on the third Monday of every month educating the students and visitors to take care of environment and protect it from pollution. WDC has always been busy organizing workshops and guest lectures on gender related issues, entrepreneurship, and women's problems.
