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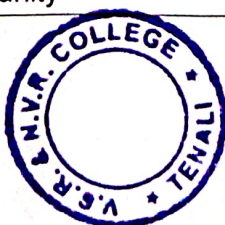

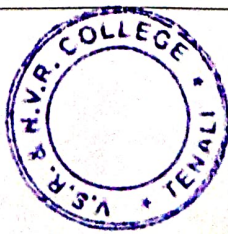
The institution prepares annual reports and shares them with the stakeholders for feedback and further improvement.
